STARTING THE YEAR OFF RIGHT

Students will be bringing home several important forms this month as we start our year off. Please return them promptly to your child's teacher when they are sent home for you to fill out. A **Student Demographics Form** will be sent home for you to make any changes in addresses, phone numbers, medical information, emergency contacts, etc. If there are 'no changes', please state this on the form, sign it, and return it.



We also need a **Photographs/Media Consent Form** completed to allow us to use student pictures for public displays such as in the newspaper, school bulletins, or class websites.

HEALTH and WELLNESS

A reminder that a visual health check needs to be done daily, **after** your child wakes up in the morning, before coming to school. If your child is not feeling well, please keep them at home.

OUTSIDE PLAYTIME

Our students will be going outside regularly. Students will need to have proper raingear including rain jackets and rain boots. A change of clothes should also be kept at school, for all students, in case of slips and falls in wet weather.

SCHOOL LUNCHES

SCHOOL PARKING LOT

We appreciate your assistance in ensuring our students arrive and depart from school safely. Parents needing to stop and come to the school are asked to park in the school parking lot or on Crestview Avenue and walk with their children down the sidewalk to the school. Please note the following details about traffic:



- **Drop-Off/Pick-Up Lane:**
- There is no parking in this lane immediately beside the school sidewalk. Students are either readily dropped off or picked up here. The driver must be in the car at all times when cars are in this lane.
- **Drive-Through Lane:**
- No parking is allowed in this lane.
